## PREFACE.

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THIS record of the deaths in Woburn for the years 1873-1890, inclusive, has been compiled from the official record in the office of the city clerk, and from the undertakers' returns on file in that office. I have also made use of the gravestone records in the Woburn Public Cemetery, and some few records obtained from private sources.

The official record kept by the city clerk is supposed to be a faithful transcript of the facts contained in the burial returns filed by the undertakers. As a matter of fact, however, these returns have not, in all cases, been correctly transcribed into the record book; so that in order to secure completeness and accuracy in this printed compilation, I have deemed it necessary to go back to the undertakers' returns, and to compare each entry in the record book with the data contained in those returns. Where there was a discrepancy the facts as given in the returns have been followed. These returns, it is true, are sometimes incomplete and very carelessly filled out; but they are much more reliable than the copy made from them and used as the official record. To illustrate: in one instance, the name Small in the undertaker's return is copied Smith into the official record; the name Purtell appears as Prentice; Wood as Ward; Reall as Reade, and again as Riral, etc., etc. In one case, the color of the deceased which was written "white" in the undertaker's return was copied into the official record book as the man's surname.

In addition to these inaccuracies I found several burial returns filed by the undertakers which had not been copied at all into the city clerk's books. In one year there were no less than eleven of these omissions. In compliance with a law passed in 1887 the undertakers' returns for the past few years have been nicely bound together and indexed conveniently for examination and reference.

A more or less complete file of the burial returns in Woburn extends back to the year 1854, and, apart from the reasons already stated, they are of great value in that they furnish certain facts not always to be found in the clerk's record; as, for example, the maiden name of the mother of the deceased is usually given in these returns but seldom appears in the clerk's record book. There are probably some of these returns to be found in the possession of families whose relatives have served as undertakers in years past, and I suggest that an effort be made by the city authorities to secure possession of these public documents for the public service.

In this connection, too, I call attention to the fact that there is no public record kept of interments made in the Woburn Public Cemetery except of persons who died in Woburn. I am informed that there are such records in the possession of present and past undertakers, but neither the city clerk nor the Board of Cemetery

Commissioners has any record whatever of interments made in Woburn of persons who have died elsewhere and have been buried in Woburn. Moreover, in the absence of a gravestone, there is no public record to indicate in what lot the body of a deceased person lies interred in our Woburn Public Cemetery. These things are certainly not as they should be, and, without desiring to criticise any one, I deem it a public duty to call attention to the facts.

I have had placed in my possession, by Mr. Edward Simonds, an old account book kept by Deacon Benjamin Wyman, grandfather of our present postmaster, Arthur B. Wyman, and a prominent man in Woburn in the early part of the century.\* This book contains an "Account of Deaths" in Woburn for the years 1815-1831, inclusive,—with a few entries for the year 1832 which were crossed out and probably copied into another book,—and appears to be one of a series of similar books kept by Deacon Wyman. It is possible that others of the series are still in existence.

In this crude little account book there are, to be sure, only two or three deaths recorded which are not found in the town clerk's book; but, in many instances, Deacon Wyman details some particulars about the deceased, or the circumstances of his death, which are interesting and valuable, and are not to be found in the town records. Sometimes he makes a brief comment about the character of the decedent; and, in some cases, he places a B. or a U. after the record to indicate that the deceased was a Baptist or a Universalist. His record sometimes states the relationship of the deceased to other persons; and, not infrequently, it supplies the month and the day of the month on which he died,—facts not always given in the town records, especially in the year 1831. I am informed that there are other similar private records in existence. If so, they should be brought to public attention.

In the following pages I have inserted, by way of foot-note, under the proper surname, such extracts from Deacon Wyman's Account Book as seemed for one reason and another, after I had compared each of his entries with the printed record of deaths 1640-1872, to contain the most valuable data. The original book will be placed in the Woburn Public Library for safe keeping and for the convenience of those who may want to consult it.

In the autumn of 1890 I copied off all the inscriptions then to be found in the Woburn Public Cemetery. The Cemetery Commissioners are about to publish this transcript *verbatim et literatim*, so that I have not inserted in this work, excepting in a few cases, anything more than the mere record of name and date of death of those persons whose names are not found on the city clerk's records.

The number of deaths here printed, exclusive of those mentioned in the foot-notes, is just 4,000.

Except where the contrary appears, the birthplace of the deceased is Woburn.
