*The same Day [Friday last, June 11] we had here an account of a sad Accident which happened at Woburn that Day. *viz.*: Mr. James Clough, with his Apprentice, John Potter, of this Town, Founder, and one Pierce, of Woburn, being in pursuit of a Copper Mine, and in order to come at it they were oblig'd to break to pieces a large Rock, and charg'd it with Powder sufficient, as they were ramming the broken pieces of Stone upon the Powder, struck Fire, which flew in at a crack that was in the Cane which held the Fuze, and instantly communicated itself to the Powder that was in the bottom of the hole, and blew them up: Mr. Clough lost his right hand then, and had his Arm so broke to pieces, and his left hand burnt to that degree that he had his right Arm and left Hand cut off the next Day; he was also much wounded in his Stomach, and his Life is in great danger. His Apprentice, John Potter, had his right Arm so burnt that it was tho't necessary, and accordingly was cut off. From *The Boston Weekly News-Letter*, Thursday, March 31, 1743:—
"Ran away from his Master Gershon Flegg of Woburn, on the 21st Instant at Night: a Negro-Man Servant, indentured for seven Years, named Pompey York, about thirty-eight Years of Age, of middling Stature, speaks good English, can read and write. He had on, or with him when he went away, a grey homespun Coat turn'd and piec'd, flat metal buttons; a blew Jacket, with metal Buttons; an old Camblet, one without Sleeves, also an old blew Shag loose Coat, and a brown Holland one; two good cotton and linnen Shiris, a pair of Leather Breeches with metal Buttons, grey Yarn Stockings, thick strong Shoes, two Castor Hats, one old, the other almost new, sundry Wigs, and a striped Cap. He has also with him Spoon Moulds, and other Tinkers' Tools. He

walks stooping and waddles as he goes. On his right Hand there are several Specks like Warts. He sometimes undertakes to Exhort, and sometimes to tell Fortunes.

"N. B. He had a Manumission of Freedom from Seth Ross and William Crosby of Billerica, before he was indented as aforesaid. Whosoever shall take up the said Servant and bring him to his Master, or secure him in Boston, Cambridge, or Charlestown Gaol, shall have Eight Pounds old Tenor Reward, and all necessary Charges paid.

"All Masters of Vessels and others are caution'd not to harbour, conceal or carry off the said Servant, as they would avoid the Penalty of the Law. Dated March 25, 1742, 3."

NOTE.—Many of the early members of the FLAGG family in Woburn preferred to write the name FLACC, which accounts for the peculiar spelling of the above advertisement. Gershom Flagg, above, was a son of the first Gershom Flagg, of Woburn, who was killed in battle with the Indians, in the year 1690. The second Gershom Flagg inherited his father's estate. Both occupied the estate known in later times as the "Fox Place." This was a mansion house which once stood on a spot immediately behind the present Unitarian Church. A history of the estate appeared in the pamphlet, "Old Houses and Homes." Gershom Flagg, the second, in 1736, deeded one half of the estate to a third Gershom Flagg, his son, who died in 1743. The second Gershom Flagg died in 1755.

Of the runaway servant, and apparent thief, no further information appears.

Caleb Blodgett in Woburn on the fifteenth day of February next at nine of the clock in the forenoon of said day for to act in all the articles, matters and things as are hereafter set forth by posting up a copy or copies of this warrant in one or more public place or places within said towns fourteen days at least before the day of said meeting as the law directs —

First To choose a proprietors clerk and get him sworn as the law directs in order to record votes and orders of said proprietors.

Secondly To choose a committee and get them sworn and impower said committee for to run lines and to establish bounds with all persons joining upon the common and undivided lands in Woburn and Wilmington aforesaid.

Thirdly To see if the proprietors will vote for to divide to each proprietor his equal part and proportion of the common lands aforesaid.

Fourthly To see if the proprietors will choose a committee and impower them for to lay out to each and every proprietor their equal part of the common lands aforesaid according to their rights.

Fifthly To see if the proprietors will vote that for the future that the proprietors clerk shall have power to make out warrants for calling proprietors meetings, when five or more of the proprietors desire it of him, the clerk posting up a copy of the warrant at one or more public place or places in said towns fourteen days before

the day of said meeting as the law directs and make return of this warrant and your doings therein at the time and place abovesaid to those proprietors aforesaid then met present. Given under my hand and seal at Billerica this twenty-fifth day of January Anno Domini 1738/9 and in the twelfth year of his Majesty's reign.
