‡ He was a tailor. In 1718 he sold his homestead of 120 acres in Woburn to Samuel Green, bounded on the east "by the highway to Charlestown from the West End of said Woburn, and north-erly and northwest by the land and meadow of Thomas Kendall, Jr." Ralph Kendall, with his wife, Abigail, then removed to Lancaster, where six of his children, including Benjamin, were born. Benjamin lived in Sherborn. He died testate in 1805, leaving a widow, Eunice; children, Benjamin, Timothy, Kezia Boden (wife of William), Lydia Holbrook (wife of Micah), Eunice Burbank (wife of Samuel), Elizabeth Houghton (wife of Benjamin); granddaughter, Asenath Pratt, and only brother, Elisha Kendall. But was Benjamin of Sherborn the son of Ralph? Apparently not.
